Changes to Medicaid Managed Care in 2018

- Notices will go out starting **November 2017** informing people of their ability to switch plans. In November, everyone enrolled in a managed care plan will be **able to switch** managed care plans. Their new plan will not become active until **January 1, 2018**.
- If someone doesn't choose a managed care plan they will be auto-enrolled in their current plan.
- After being auto-enrolled or enrolling, individuals will have **90 days to switch** care plans starting January 1, 2018.
- Cook County residents who were in **Family Health Network** or **Community Care Alliance of Illinois** plans will be auto-enrolled in **CountyCare** on **November 1, 2017**.
- Residents of the Collar Counties or Rockford Region who were in the **Family Health Network** or **Community Care Alliance of Illinois** plans will be auto-enrolled in **IlliniCare** on **January 1, 2018**.
- Cook County residents who were enrolled in the other **3 discontinued plans** will be able to **switch plans** after receiving a notice in November. If they don't choose a new plan they will be auto-enrolled in a plan.
